**An Act to Maintain the Current Footprint  
and Certain Requirements  
of the Otter Lake Landfill**

Be it enacted by the Governor and Assembly as follows:

- 1** This Act may be cited as the *Otter Lake Landfill Act*.
  - 2** In this Act,
    - (a) “cell” means a solid waste residuals disposal cell;
    - (b) “Landfill” means the municipal solid waste landfill located at or near 600 Otter Lake Drive in the Municipality;
    - (c) “Municipality” means the Halifax Regional Municipality;
    - (d) “operator” means the operator of the Landfill.
  - 3**
    - (1)** Notwithstanding the *Environment Act*, the regulations made pursuant to that Act or any other enactment,
      - (a) the Landfill is limited to nine cells; and
      - (b) none of the cells in the Landfill may exceed 113 metres in height above sea level except as approved by the Department of Environment before the coming into force of this Act.
    - (2)** Notwithstanding clause (1)(b), cell number 6 in the Landfill may, with the approval of the Department of Environment, have a height not exceeding 119 metres above sea level for a maximum of one year immediately following that approval.
