CH A P . 2

An Act to authorize a subscription of one hundred thousand dollars for the assistance of the sufferers from the explosion which has laid waste the city of Halifax and neighborhood

[Assented to 9th February, 1918]

WHEREAS it is expedient to assist the sufferers from the explosion which has laid waste the city of Halifax and neighborhood, and, for that purpose, to subscribe a sum of one hundred thousand dollars in the name of the Province, and to provide for the manner of payment of such subscription;

Therefore His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Provincial Treasurer is authorized to subscribe, in the name of the Province, a sum of one hundred thousand dollars for the purpose of assisting the sufferers from the explosion which has laid waste the city of Halifax and neighborhood.

2. Payment of such subscription shall be made by the Provincial Treasurer to the persons and in the manner to be determined by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

3. Such subscription of one hundred thousand dollars shall be paid out of the consolidated revenue fund of the Province.
