## Bill #82 Offshore Licensing Policy Act

## CHANGES RECOMMENDED TO THE LAW AMENDMENTS COMMITTEE BY THE MINISTER OF ENERGY

PAGE 1, Clause 1, line 1 - delete "Licencing" and substitute "Licensing".

PAGE 2, paragraph 6(b), lines 1 and 2 - delete "no petroleum licensing or commercial seismic activities take place on Georges Bank" and substitute "the moratorium be maintained".

## PAGE 2, Clause 7 -

- (a) line 1 delete and substitute:
- 7 (1) On or before December 31, 2022, the Minister may examine the available environmental and socio-economic evidence related to the impact of exploration and drilling activities on Georges Bank.
- (2) Where, based on the examination under subsection (1), the Minister is of the opinion that
- (b) 2nd last line delete "may" and substitute "shall";
- (c) 2nd last line add "in accordance with Section 8" immediately after "review";
- (d) add the following:
- (3) The Minister shall not order a public review before December 31, 2022.
- (4) Where, based upon the examination under subsection (1), the Minister does not form the opinion referred to in subsection (2), the Minister shall not order a public review, but shall continue to exercise the Minister's power and discretion in the manner provided in clause 6(a).
- (5) Where the moratorium is still in effect in whole or in part, the Minister may conduct an examination under subsection (1) on or before the end of each ten-year period following 2022.
- (6) The Minister shall publish notice of the outcome of an examination under subsection (1) in the Royal Gazette.

## PAGE 2, subclause 8(1) -

- (a) line 1 delete "Executive Council" and substitute "the Minister";
- (b) lines 1 and 2 delete "Executive Council" and substitute "review must consider the environmental and socio-economic impact of exploration and drilling for petroleum on Georges Bank and the Minister".
