## CHANGES RECOMMENDED TO THE LAW AMENDMENTS COMMITTEE

### PAGE 8, proposed subsection 25AF(1) - delete and substitute the following subsection:

25AF(1) On the expiry date of a contract, if notice is not given by the customer under clause (b) and subsection (1) of Section 25AE, customers must be placed on an indeterminate month-to-month service arrangement on the same terms and conditions they were operating under during their fixed-term period, except that there must be no charge related to leasing or purchasing the phone where the original contract contemplated that the phone would become the property of the customer after completing certain conditions and those conditions have been met.

# DEFEATED

#### PAGE 12, proposed Section 25AO - add the following subsection:

(5) Nothing in subsection (4) of Section 25N or clause (d) of subsection (1) authorizes the Government of the Province to give, send or serve notice or other document to cellular telephone customers except in the event of a public emergency or matters of urgent public safety.
