Subject: Proposed Amendments

The Nova Scotia government introduced proposed amendments to the Animal Protection Act – Bill 27 (An Act to Protect Animals and to Aid Animals that are in Distress) on September 13. The changes include a ban on cropping and docking procedures and an increase to the search and seize powers of the Nova Scotia SPCA.

I received an e-mail with this up and coming amendment attached, from an organization I belong to. While I can understand the importance of keeping the "breed standard", it is far more important to me that animals in general are looked after, protected, sheltered and given a voice and if that takes the SPCA to do it, then they have my full support.
