I think it should continue .

Reasons why:

I have had 4 Brittanys over the last 35 years, 3 have had there tails docked, the present puppy purchased this year from the USA is born tailless, I had to purchase the puppy from the USA because the only other puppy I could find was in BC and it had a tail.

The Brittany is a bird hunting dog which hunts in some pretty tough county, it can easily hurt its tail in the underbrush, if this happens there is many weeks of pain and suffering until the tail heals.

Also the breed standard for the Brittany is no tail or docked and no more then 4" long.

Please remove the tail docking issue from bill 27.
