PAGES 1 and 2, Clause 3 - add the following Section after proposed Section 23D:

23E The Minister shall offer funding to municipalities, either individually or as a group through the Nova Scotia Federation of Municipalities, to assist them in preparing and implementing codes of conduct.

PAGE 2, Clause 5 - add the following Section after proposed Section 408AE:

108AF The Minister shall offer funding to villages, either individually or as a group through the Nova Scotia Federation of Municipalities, to assist them in preparing and implementing codes of conduct.

PAGE 4, Clause 10 - add the following Section after proposed Section 20D:

20E The Minister shall offer funding to the Municipality, either individually or through the Nova Scotia Federation of Municipalities, to assist it in preparing and implementing a code of conduct.

PAGE 1, Clause 2, proposed subsection 71(3) -

- (a) add ", at its discretion," immediately after "may" in the first line; and
- (b) add ", recognizing that the Government will continue to fund the majority of required grant support for small businesses to meet the requirements under the Accessibility Act" immediately after "disabilities" in the third line.
