CHANGES RECOMMENDED TO THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE HOUSE ON BILLS

PAGE 2, paragraph 7(b) - delete and substitute the following:

- (b) to support, strengthen and set targets for energy efficiency programming while prioritizing equitable access and benefits for low income and marginalized Nova Scotians by
 - (i) developing an energy efficiency resource standard in the next Provincial climate plan to cover all energy sources and savings attributable to Efficiency Nova Scotia activities,
 - (ii) developing a plan to eliminate oil heating in the Province by 2050 at the latest, with interim targets for fossil fuel savings and the number of buildings undergoing deep retrofits,
 - (iii) setting a minimum target of electricity demand-side management annual savings equal to one and a half per cent of sales, which may be increased by the Minister or by order of the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board when greater energy savings are considered cost-effective or complementary to achieve renewable energy targets and net-zero emissions, or considered to increase social and economic benefits within the Province, and
 - (iv) establishing a minimum budget for low-income energy efficiency programs designed to reduce energy poverty in all plans to meet energy efficiency resource standard requirements;
