Bill #96 Dismantling Racism and Hate Act

CHANGES RECOMMENDED TO THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE HOUSE ON BILLS

PAGE 5, add the following Clause after Clause 13:

- 14 (1) Upon the coming into force of this Act, police officers in the Province are prohibited from collecting, releasing or retaining identifying information about an individual who has not been arrested or charged with an offence.
- (2) In furtherance of the duty to serve and protect, police officers shall interact with and rely on members of the public to provide investigative and intelligence information, provided the interaction is consensual on the part of the member of the public.
- (3) For greater certainty, subsections (1) and (2) do not apply to individuals driving motor vehicles detained at random checkpoints designated for every passing motor vehicle.
- (4) A police officer may for the use of the police officer make a record of interactions with members of the public.
